6. CHURCH CONDEMNATION

The Mormon Church is under condemnation for not following the Book of Mormon:

- 54 And your **MINDS** in times past have been **DARKENED** because of unbelief, and because you have treated lightly the things you have received—
- 55 Which vanity and unbelief have brought the whole church under CONDEMNATION.
- 56 And this condemnation resteth upon the children of Zion, even all.
- 57 And they shall REMAIN under this condemnation until they repent and remember the new covenant, even the Book of Mormon and the former commandments which I have given them, not only to say, BUT TO DO according to that which I have written—(D&C 84 1832)

The Book of Mormon was to restore lost doctrine, not have new doctrine added:

40 Whoso shall declare more or less than this [Book of Mormon] and establish it for my doctrine the same cometh of evil (3 Nephi 11)


7. NO ADDITIONAL RECORDS

Mormons were promised additional records IF they were faithful to the Book of Mormon:

- 9 And when they shall have received this, which is expedient that they should have first to try their faith and if it shall so be that they shall believe these things then shall the greater things be made manifest unto them. (3 Nephi 26)
- 2 And then, behold, **other records have I**, that I will give unto **you [Joseph & Oliver]** power that you may assist to translate. (D&C 9)

Additional records pertaining to the Book of Mormon have not come forth. President Benson said the Church was still under condemnation:

We have felt that scourge and judgment! We must first cleanse the inner vessel by awaking and arising, being morally clean, using the Book of Mormon in a manner so that GOD WILL LIFT THE CONDEMNATION (Ezra Taft Benson, Ensign, May, 1986, p. 4)



1. BAPTISM OF CHILDREN

The Book of Mormon says DO NOT baptize children:

11 And their **little children need no repentance**, **neither baptism**. Behold, baptism is unto repentance to the fulfilling the commandments unto the remission of sins.

14 Behold I say unto you, that he that supposeth that little children need baptism is in the gall of bitterness and in the bonds of iniquity; (Moroni 8)

Joseph Smith added an age mandate—and for sins:

27 And their children shall be baptized for the remission of their sins when eight years old (D&C 68)

2. BAPTISM FOR CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

Joseph added baptism for Church membership:

37 Shall be received by baptism into His Church (D&C 20)

This is what the Book of Mormon says:

35 **Whosoever repented** of their sins and did confess them them **he did number among the people of the church** (Mosiah 26)

Joseph and Oliver were baptized for the remission of sins May 1829, and then for church membership April 1830.

3. COMMUNION TO THE UNBAPTIZED

The Church gives Communion/Sacrament to INFANTS and NON-MEMBERS contrary to the Book of Mormon:

The sacrament is for Church members, **including children**. The person conducting the meeting should not announce that it will be passed to members only; **nothing should be done to prevent nonmembers from partaking of** it. ("Priesthood Ordinances and Blessings," *Family Guidebook*, 2006)

11 This shall ye always do to those who repent and are baptized in my name (3 Nephi 18)

4. POLYGAMY

Polygamy was strictly forbidden in the Book of Mormon. Joseph tied it to Exaltation—this had never been done before—there is not a second witness for it

27 There shall not any man among you have save it be ONE wife (Jacob 2)

Polygamists could not hold a Church office:

Bishops, husband of ONE wife -1 Tim. 3:2

Elders, husband of ONE wife -Titus 1:6

Deacons, husband of ONE wife -1 Tim, 3:12

Polygamy was only used to procreate:

30 For if I will, saith the Lord, raise up seed unto me, I will command my people. (Jacob 2)

Joseph had 30+ wives with whom he didn't procreate.

5. SALVATION

There is only one way to be saved in the Kingdom of God—by following Jesus:

38 And again I say unto you, ye must **repent**, and be **baptized in my name**, and become as a little child, or ye can in nowise inherit the **kingdom of God**.

40 Whoso shall declare more or less than this and establish it for my doctrine the same cometh of evil (3 Nephi 11)

Joseph inserted himself into all covenants, including baptism:

7 All covenants, contracts, bonds, obligations, oaths, vows, performances, connections, associations, or expectations, that are not made and entered into...through the MEDIUM of mine anointed, whom I have appointed on the earth to hold this power and I have appointed unto my servant JOSEPH SMITH to hold this power in the last days...are of no efficacy (D&C 132)

Salvation is through the **authority of the name of Jesus Christ**—not priesthoods. **All** Believers can use the name of Jesus Christ to cast out devils, heal the sick, raise the dead, **and baptize**.
